On Wednesday 9 September 2020, at 17.30 hrs., at the Press Room, 1<sup>st</sup> floor, Parliament Building, Hon. Pol.Capt. Arun Sawasdee, the 5<sup>th</sup> Vice-Chairperson of the Committee on Legal Affairs, Justice and Human Rights, and Hon. Mr. Sattra Sripan, Spokesperson of the Committee received complaint documents from Mr. Nat Eamrungroj, a victim, in case he was unable to withdraw money from the UAG Trade of Thailand which is represented by Leonine Global (THAILAND) Co., Ltd. for financial operations, deposits, and investment intermediaries for investors from UAG Trade (Thailand) and UAG Global. They do business in the Foreign Exchange Market (Forex) while Leonine Global (THAILAND) Co., Ltd. has a function to perform financial transactions such as receiving deposits from investors, so they will be able to enter and trade Forex. As a result, there are more than 8 million victims and the value of the economic losses are more than 1,000 million baht. We will propose it to the committee, to push for amendment and change the laws relating with this issue to be more up-to-dated and to prevent investment fraud," Mr. Sattra Sripan said after receiving complaint documents.
